Details:

On Thursday, March 29, 2018, a Boone County man was arrested for 1 count Possession of Child pornography, Class B felony.

The investigation leading to the arrest began after the University of Missouri Police Department investigated the suspect on March 12, 2018 for an incident on campus. A phone was collected and examined for the University's investigation. Subsequently, a forensic examiner located evidence of child pornography on the suspects phone.

The Task Force served a court order search warrant on March 29th at a Columbia residence and seized several pieces of evidence. The suspect was taken into custody for the possession of child pornography.

The suspect is identified as 21-year-old, Jacob Vanderlinde who resides at 1607 Sylvan Lane, located in Columbia, Missouri. Bond is to be set.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigations, and the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's office.
