Incident: Man Arrested- Internet crimes arrest

Location: 100 block of Nifong Blvd

Details:

On Monday, April 23, 2018, a Columbia man was arrested for 1 count Attempted Child Enticement of a Child and 1 count sexual misconduct with a minor.

The investigation leading to the arrest began after the suspect responded to a post made by an undercover decoy from the Task Force, masquerading as a 14-year-old female. Conversations were exchanged between the UC and defendant through messaging. Furthermore, the suspect asked the decoy if they could meet to engage in sex. Arrangements were made with the defendant to meet at a location in Columbia.

On April 23, 2018, the suspect showed up at the predetermined location and the suspect was taken in custody.

The suspect is identified as 24-year-old, Harrison Cooper Stretz who resides at 310 Cumberland Drive, located in Columbia, Missouri. Bond has not been set at this time.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
