Incident: Deputy Involved Shooting; Burglary Suspect Arrested
Location: 4800 block of Schooner Road & Meadowlark Lane
Date & time: 10/29/18 @ 1249 hours

Details:

An armed burglary suspect was shot by a Boone County sheriff's deputy after fleeing from a residence in the 4800 block of Schooner Road this afternoon (10/29/2018).

Two deputies responded to the residence shortly before 1 p.m. after a nearby citizen reported two men breaking in through a back door. Deputies confronted both suspects as they exited the front door. A foot pursuit ensued across Schooner Road through back yards and onto Meadowlark Lane.

At that time one of the suspects pointed a pistol at a deputy who fired shots. The suspect, Deandre E. Lewis-Gatewood, 24, was transported to a local hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. Lewis-Gatewood, 24, was later released from the hospital and taken to the Boone County Jail on suspicion of Burglary 1st degree, armed criminal action and resisting arrest. Bond has not yet been set. The second suspect is still at large.

The Missouri State Highway Patrol has taken over the investigation into the deputy involved shooting and any further inquiries should be directed to that agency.
