Incident: Man Arrested- Possession and Promoting of Child Pornography

Location: 600 Block West Rollins, Moberly, Missouri

Case Number: 18-4066

Details:

On Wednesday, November 21, 2018, a Randolph County man was arrested for 1 count Possession of Child pornography, Class B felony and 1 count of Promoting Child Pornography, Class B felony.

The investigation leading to the arrest began after an investigator with the Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force received a tip from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children that someone was using an online cloud storage application to collect and trade child pornography.

The Task Force served a court ordered search warrant on November 21st at a Moberly residence and seized several pieces of evidence. The suspect was taken into custody for the possession and promoting of child pornography.

The suspect is identified as 24-year-old, Evan White, who resides at 614 West Rollins Street, located in Moberly, Missouri. Bond was set at \$40,000 cash or surety.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. No Photograph was available at this time.

The Boone County Sheriff's Department Cyber Crimes Task Force is comprised of investigators from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the University of Missouri Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigations, and the Boone County Prosecuting Attorney's office.
