Incident: Motor Vehicle Pursuit Leads to Arrest
Location: 4800 Block of Meadowlark Lane

Details:

On 04/22/2020, at approximately 4:15 p.m., Boone County deputies were dispatched to a residence in the 4800 block of Meadowlark Lane to investigate a report of a residential burglary in progress. The complainant advised a male suspect, who they identified as Matthew Baumann, was trying to break into their residence and had made threats to shoot people. The complainant was able to provide a description of a motorcycle, to include registration information, that Baumann was operating.

As deputies were responding to the scene, they located Baumann leaving the area on the motorcycle. Deputies tried to stop Baumann, who fled on the motorcycle and a motor vehicle pursuit ensued. The pursuit traveled north on Ponderosa Street, east on New Haven Road, through portions of Boone County east of Columbia, and ended on Keene Street when Baumann laid the motorcycle down in business parking lot and fled on foot toward Highway 63. Baumann crossed Highway 63 and was apprehended in the parking lot for Hy-Vee on Conley Road.

Baumann, age 22 of Columbia, was found to be in possession of a bulk quantity of marijuana, a significant amount of currency, packaging material, and related drug paraphernalia. Baumann's driver's license/privilege was also found to be suspended and he had an active misdemeanor warrant for his arrest for resisting or interfering with an arrest/detention.

In addition to being arrested for his outstanding active warrant, Baumann was arrested on the following charges:

- Delivery of a Controlled Substance – Felony – RSMo 579.020
- Resisting Arrest/Detention/Stop by Fleeing – Felony – RSMo 575.150
- Driving While Revoked/Suspended – 1st Offense – Misdemeanor – RSMo 302.321

- Operated a Motor Vehicle in a Careless or Imprudent Manner – Misdemeanor – RSMo 304.012

Suspects are considered innocent until found guilty in a court of law.
