Type of Incident: Vehicle Pursuit

Date & Time: April 9, 2008 around 0011 hours

Details of the Incident:

On April 9, 2008 at approximately 0011 hours, Deputies from the Boone County Sheriff's Department and Officers from the Columbia and Ashland Police Departments responded to assist the Missouri State Highway Patrol with a vehicle pursuit. The pursuit began in the area of Highway WW and Rangeline Road.

The suspect vehicle was four wheel drive and left the roadway traveling through muddy fields. Officers, Troopers, and Deputies on foot located the vehicle in a field apparently attempting to hide from law enforcement. After driving through more fields to evade officers, the vehicle traveled South on Rangeline Road and into more fields near David Allen Road. A helicopter from the Highway Patrol and four wheel drive police vehicles were called to the scene.

At approximately 0137 hours the vehicle traveled into a muddy field in the area of the 7200 block of South Rangeline Road. The driver fled on foot and the passenger surrendered.

Boone County Sheriff's K-9 Utz was already on the scene. After an approximate half-mile track through the field the second suspect was located and taken into custody.

Arrested in this incident were Larry Creason, 46, and Shawn Knight, 29, both of Columbia.

At the time of this release the investigation was still on-going. No current suspect photographs or current list of charges were available.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven otherwise in a court of law.
