Media Release WARRANT ARREST

Details:

On 4-16-08 at 12:07 pm, Boone County deputies responded to a possible robbery/home invasion at 7183 Wagon Trail Road, lot 16 of Wagon Wheel Trailer Park. The victim provided deputies with a name, date of birth and social security number as is typically gathered in the course of an investigation. The case was turned over to the Investigative Unit at the Sheriff's Department for further investigation. As the investigation progressed however, suspicion arose as to the actual identity of the victim.

Computer checks of the personal information the victim reported to be his own indicated such identifiers had also been used by a subject named Quentin Tyrone Madison, age 31, of Miami, Florida. A Florida warrant existed on the charge of 1st degree murder for a Quentin Tyrone Madison, for a 2001 homicide in Miami.

Additionally, it was discovered a subject had been arrested in Kansas City, Missouri in early April 2008 using the same identifiers the robbery victim provided Boone County deputies. Photographs were obtained from Florida and Kansas City authorities that in comparison appeared to be the Madison subject. The information the subject provided to Kansas City at the time of his arrest, and to Boone County deputies on April 16th, actually belonged to another individual whose photo did not match the Madison subject. Fingerprints from both agencies were analyzed by a Kansas City Crime Lab analyst who confirmed the person arrested in Kansas City, was actually Madison. Boone County deputies that originally responded to the robbery call on April 16th, viewed the photos and identified the victim they dealt with as Madison.

Boone County detectives on May 6th, 2008 began surveillance of Madison's residence in Wagon Wheel Trailer Park. At 6:05 pm, Madison exited his mobile home and began working on a vehicle at which time he was arrested without incident on the Florida murder warrant. Madison remains in the Boone County Jail with no bond. Florida authorities have been notified and are responding to Boone County.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
