Burglary, Resisting Arrest, Domestic Assault, Property Damage

Incident: Burglary in Progress
Location: El Chaparral Subdivision

Details;

On 06-14-2008 at about 4:30am, Deputies responded to burglary in progress at a residence in the El Chaparral subdivision. The female victim reported that a subject known to her was attempting to force entry into her residence. Prior to the arrival of Deputies, the male subject entered the house and assaulted the victim. When Deputies arrived at the residence, the suspect fled on foot and was not apprehended. The victim refused medical attention and reported no injuries.

Several attempts were made to locate the suspect at a residence in Columbia. On 06-16-2008 at about 12:45pm, the suspect surrendered at the Boone County Sheriff's Department.

Quincy L. Avant, a 35 year old resident of Columbia, was arrested for the following:

- Burglary, 1st degree. Bond, to be set by a judge.
- Domestic Assault, 2nd degree. \$4,500 bond.
- Resisting Arrest, felony. \$4,500 bond.
- Property Damage, 2nd degree. \$500 bond.

Avant's bond was \$9,500.00. The bond amount for the Burglary charge must be set by a judge at the suspect's request. Thus, the total bond amount will likely be greater than \$9,500.00.

All suspects are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
