## Agency response

Boone County's population is growing rapidly, experiencing an increase of over 7.6% since the 2010 census. U.S. Census Bureau data as of July 2015, estimates Boone County's population at 174,974. The City of Columbia is the metropolitan center of Boone County and is the home to the state's flagship university, two other smaller colleges and many satellite college campuses. Columbia is the regional hub for employment in the education, medical (5 hospitals), insurance and manufacturing industries. Columbia also hosts multiple shopping, sporting and entertainment venues which draw visitors from all over the country. Boone County has the convergence of two major highways ((Interstate 70 and U.S. Highway 63), and its population is greater during the day than at any other time with commuting
